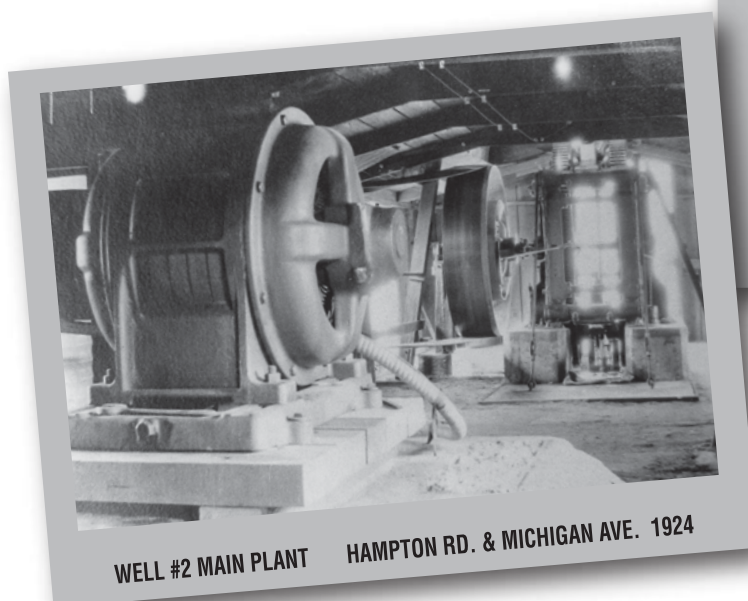
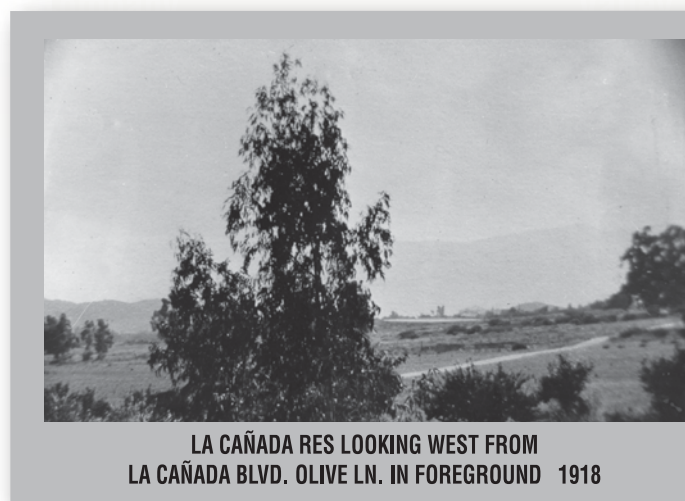
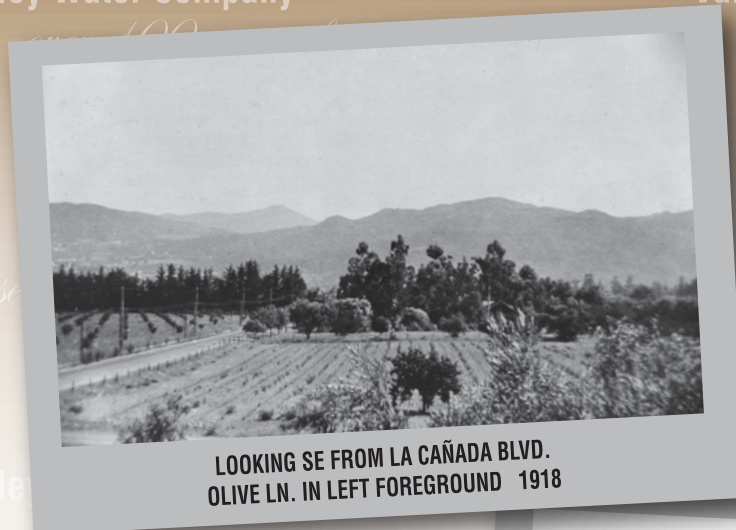
Valley Water Company of La Cañada was founded by Mrs. W.T. Somes and F.D. Lanterman on October 1, 1910. Valley Water Company; however, was organized prior to that time, its Articles of Incorporation having been signed on September 27, 1910 and it took over the affairs of Valley Water Company of La Cañada on June 13, 1911. At that time, the Lanterman Well was developed, making Valley Water Company the first producer of any real amount of dependable well water in the area. As a result, a land boom started. By 1925 over 19 miles of water main was installed with about 390 service connections. (Source: History of Valley Water Company by A.E. Harrel 1977)

Today, we have about 57 miles of water main with about 3,580 service connections. Approximately 25 percent of our water supply is comprised of well water. The other 75 percent is imported water from Metropolitan Water District, purchased through Foothill Municipal Water District. We continue to make system improvements and search to secure water resource with the goal of maintaining quality, reliability and meeting ever more stringent regulatory requirements.
